Commitment to Achieving Net Zero:

AMI Ltd is committed to achieving **Net Zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050** in support of the UK Government's Net Zero Strategy and the **NHS Net Zero Supplier Roadmap**.

The Company is committed to continually reducing its greenhouse gas emissions through responsible environmental management, sustainable procurement, operational efficiency and ongoing improvement, while supporting the sustainability objectives of NHS organisations and wider UK public sector customers.

Baseline Emissions Footprint:

Baseline emissions refer to the historical records of greenhouse gases produced before any emission reduction strategies were implemented. These emissions serve as a reference point for measuring future reductions in greenhouse gas emissions.

Additional Details relating to the Baseline Emissions calculations

AMI Ltd has confidently implemented emissions data collection in strict accordance with the Streamlined Energy and Carbon Reporting (SECR) requirements for the financial year ending 31 July 2020. We have successfully compiled Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions data for two reporting years, establishing the first year as our baseline.

Although comprehensive Scope 3 data was not required for these two years, we proactively included vehicle emissions in our Scope 3 calculations, adhering to the relevant reporting guidance.

Our data collection has been thorough, utilising all available business records, expense bills, and receipts. We are committed to ensuring the accuracy of our emissions assessments by relying on actual data rather than average data methodologies whenever possible.

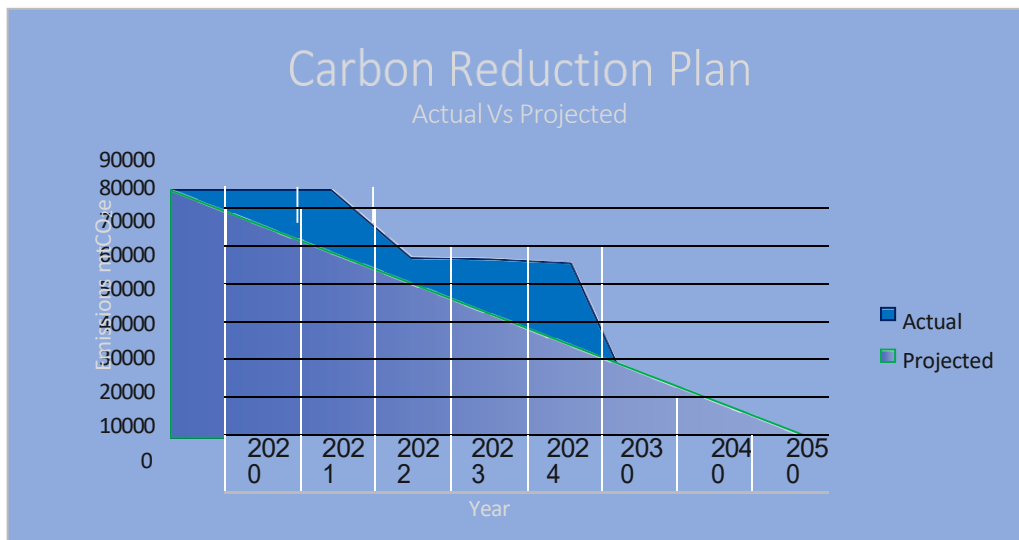
To reduce emissions associated with business travel and commuting, AMI Ltd continues to support flexible and hybrid working arrangements where operationally appropriate. The Company also promotes the use of video conferencing and other digital collaboration tools to minimise unnecessary travel while maintaining effective communication and service delivery.

We work collaboratively with our customers and supply chain partners to increase the use of secure digital documentation and electronic workflows, including electronic signature platforms such as DocuSign, reducing paper consumption and improving operational efficiency.

The Company is committed to reducing transport-related emissions through the ongoing review of its vehicle strategy, including the transition to lower-emission and electric vehicles where operationally and commercially feasible.

During the 2023 reporting period, AMI Ltd reviewed and strengthened its greenhouse gas reporting processes to improve the accuracy, consistency and completeness of emissions data. This enabled the Company to establish a robust reporting framework and develop measurable interim carbon reduction targets that support its long-term commitment to achieving Net Zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050. Since launching its Net Zero pathway in 2022, the Company has continued to implement year-on-year carbon reduction initiatives, monitor performance against established targets and identify further opportunities to reduce greenhouse gas emissions across its operations and supply chain.

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Carbon Reduction Strategy

AMI Ltd is committed to achieving Net Zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050 through a structured programme of operational improvements, responsible procurement, supplier engagement and continual environmental performance management.

Since establishing our 2021 baseline, the Company has successfully embedded sustainability into its day-to-day operations and strategic decision-making. These initiatives support compliance with Procurement Policy Note (PPN) 06/21, the NHS Net Zero Supplier Roadmap and wider UK Government sustainability objectives. Between 2021 and 2026, reported greenhouse gas emissions have reduced from **76.63 mtCO₂e** to **51.72 mtCO₂e**, representing a reduction of **24.91 mtCO₂e (32.5%)** over the reporting period. This demonstrates the effectiveness of the Company's carbon reduction programme and its commitment to continual environmental improvement. The Company remains committed to maintaining and enhancing these measures throughout the duration of all public sector contracts.

Carbon Reduction Initiatives

To reduce our carbon emissions, AMI Ltd has implemented a range of environmental initiatives, including:

- Appointing an Environmental Sustainability Lead to oversee our carbon reduction programme.
- Supporting hybrid and flexible working to reduce commuting emissions.
- Using renewable or lower-carbon electricity suppliers where available.
- Increasing the use of recycled and sustainable office furniture, packaging and materials.
- Reducing paper usage through digital working and electronic documentation.
- Considering environmental performance when selecting suppliers.
- Promoting recycling and reducing waste across the business.
- Encouraging virtual meetings and sustainable travel where appropriate.

These initiatives have helped AMI Ltd achieve year-on-year reductions in greenhouse gas emissions while supporting the sustainability objectives of the NHS and wider public sector.

Planned Carbon Reduction Programme (2026–2028)

AMI Ltd is committed to continually improving its environmental performance and will:

- Set annual carbon reduction targets and monitor progress.
- Improve Scope 3 emissions reporting by working more closely with suppliers.
- Encourage suppliers to reduce their environmental impact.
- Increase the use of digital documentation to reduce paper consumption.
- Continue Carbon Literacy training and staff engagement.
- Promote energy efficiency and waste reduction across the business.
- Review opportunities to introduce lower-emission vehicles.
- Share our sustainability progress through our website and customer communications.
- Review appropriate carbon offsetting opportunities after prioritising direct emissions reductions.

These actions will support our commitment to achieving Net Zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050 and align with the NHS Net Zero Supplier Roadmap and UK Government procurement requirements.

Continual Improvement

Environmental performance is reviewed annually as part of the Company's management review process. Carbon emissions data, reduction initiatives, emerging risks and future opportunities are monitored to ensure continual improvement and ongoing compliance with evolving UK Government procurement requirements and NHS sustainability expectations.

As environmental reporting standards continue to develop, Aayan Medical Imaging Ltd will seek opportunities to improve the quality of emissions reporting, strengthen supplier collaboration and integrate sustainability



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considerations throughout its business operations.

Declaration and Sign-Off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been prepared in accordance with Procurement Policy Note (**PPN**) 06/21, the Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Protocol Corporate Accounting and Reporting Standard, the Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Standard, the Streamlined Energy and Carbon Reporting (**SECR**) Regulations, and the latest UK Government Greenhouse Gas Conversion Factors.

The reported greenhouse gas emissions have been calculated using recognised methodologies and reflect AMI Ltd's commitment to transparent environmental reporting, continual improvement and responsible corporate governance.

Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions have been reported in accordance with SECR requirements together with the applicable Scope 3 emissions required under PPN 06/21 and current NHS Carbon Reduction Plan guidance. This Carbon Reduction Plan has been reviewed and approved by the Board of Directors and demonstrates Aayan Medical Imaging Ltd's ongoing commitment to reducing greenhouse gas emissions, supporting the NHS Net Zero Supplier Roadmap and achieving Net Zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050.
